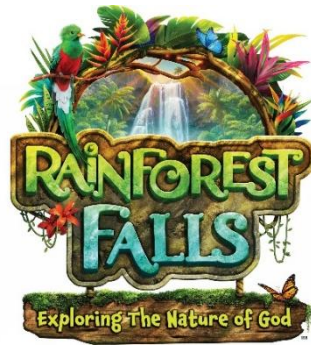


Portrait of a



Crew Leader

Who you are:

- **An enthusiastic Christian believer, who loves and respects children.**
- **A leader of a crew of 5-6 children, all of similar age (you can indicate age preferences when doing online registration), usually made up of boys and girls: Together you will all move to the various Activity Stations.**
- **An encouraging team-player for your assistant.**

What you bring:

- **A spirit of joy and leadership by example.**
- **A willingness to tell your story of faith if questions come up.** (It is required to indicate your home church, especially if you are new to our VBS.)
- **A desire to help your assistant develop co-responsibility.**
- **A commitment to (ideally) all 5 days – and to arrive in good time (best by 9:45 - and ideally even earlier on the first day!!) to be present to welcome ‘your’ kids.**

What you receive:

- **Usually a Crew Leader Assistant to support you and the crew kids (often a younger person)**
- **The assurance that the various Station Leaders will explain what each session is about.**
- **A printed Crew Leader Guide with tips and advice.** (An electronic copy will be provided ahead of VBS.)
- **A printed Guide (plus Activity Sheets for the kids) to use during the special Station that is “Circle-up Time”.** (The most “quiet” session of VBS where a crew gets to know each other better) (An electronic copy will be provided ahead of VBS.)
- **A printed schedule and church map so you know when and where to go next.**
- **Crew Leader ID / name badge.**
- **List of names of ‘your’ crew children.**
- **Lots of healthy exercise for body and soul – and many smiles from ‘your’ kids!**
